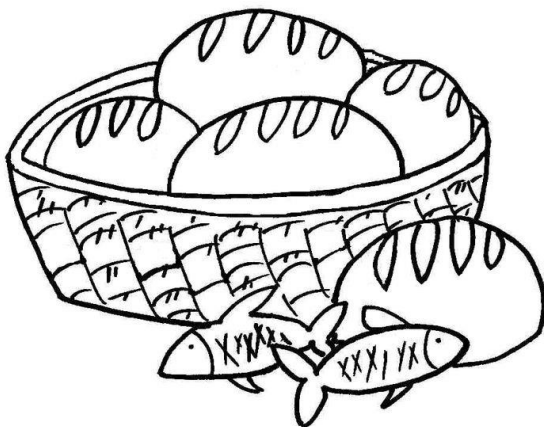

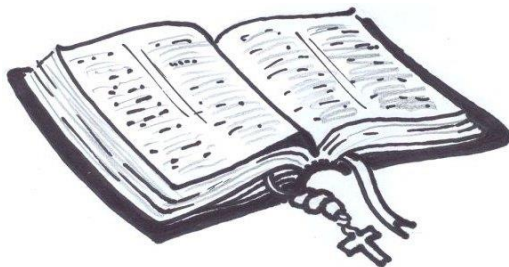

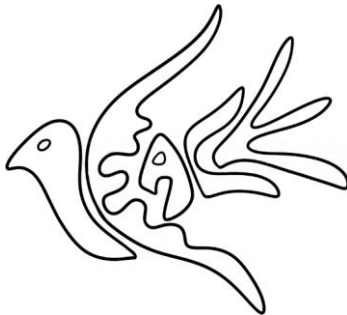

The Preparation of the Altar

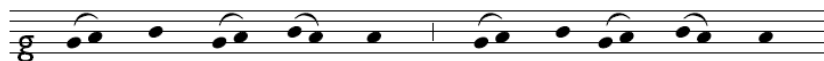
