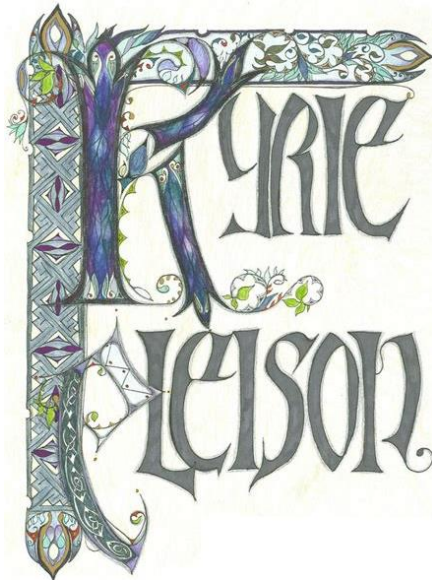
In a moment of quietness, let us prepare ourselves

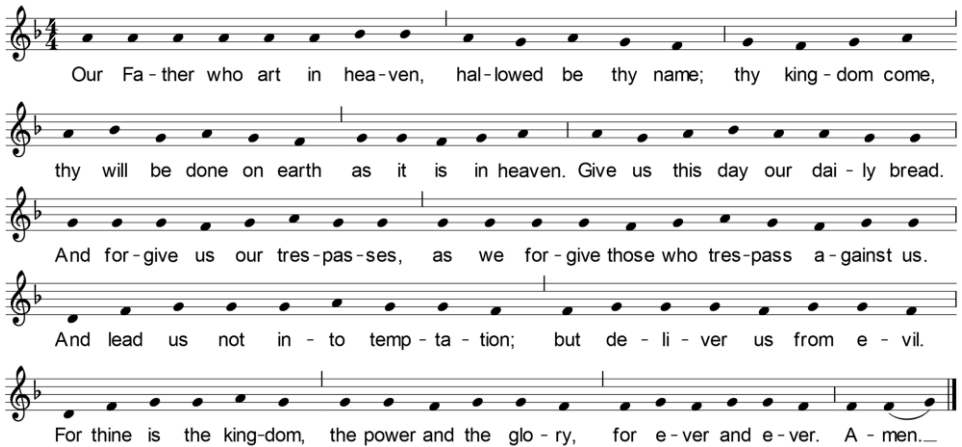
